### Preliminary Regional Issues Assessment Hawkins and Rumker, Central West NSW

The NSW Department of Planning, Industry and Environment is seeking community feedback to help the NSW Government decide whether to release the Hawkins and Rumker areas for coal exploration. These areas are located west of Mudgee and north of Rylstone.

The Department has been asked to prepare a Preliminary Regional Issues Assessment by the Advisory Body for Strategic Release.

The purpose of this assessment is to identify any social, environmental and economic opportunities and constraints associated with releasing the areas for exploration of an underground coal resource.

The assessment is a standard part of the NSW Government's process when considering whether to release areas for exploration. The process is established under the Strategic Release Framework.


The assessment will be considered by the Advisory Body for Strategic Release, which will make recommendations to the Minister for Regional NSW as to whether the areas should be released.

The Preliminary Regional Issues Assessment does not pre-empt the assessment of any potential future coal extraction projects and does not guarantee that any future approvals will be granted by the NSW Government.

Community consultation is a vital part of the process, and the Department is welcoming feedback from the community and other stakeholders until **28 July 2021**.

### Traffic Notice – Road Closures and Clearways SMH Half Marathon – Sunday 27 June 2021

Major roads will close in the Sydney CBD and Pyrmont for the annual Sydney Morning Herald Half Marathon on Sunday 27 June 2021.

Roads will start closing from 2am with major roads closing from 4am including sections of the Western Distributor and the Cahill Expressway Overpass. All roads will reopen by 1pm.

Special event clearways will be in effect at varying times between 1.30am and 12.30pm on key roads in the Sydney CBD, Circular Quay, The Rocks, Millers Point, Barangaroo, Pyrmont and Ultimo. Affected roads include but are not limited to Hickson Road, Sussex Street, George Street, Kent Street, Clarence Street, College Street, Park Street, Bridge Street, Bathurst Street, Macquarie Street, Pirrama Road and Pyrmont Street.

Clearways are strict no-parking zones, and also apply to local residents and businesses or RMS Mobility Scheme Permit holders. Check signs carefully for clearway times before parking. Vehicles left in clearways will be towed and a fee applies.
